School Day Start Time Reminder

Thank you so much for supporting our new morning arrangements. As a reminder, our official school day starts at 8.45am. Registers are taken at 8.45am. To support this earlier registration, the gates open at 8.35am and children go into class at 8.40am, ready for registration at 8.45am. The school gates close at 8.45am. Any children arriving after 8.45am need to enter school via the main entrance at the school office. Children arriving after 8.45am but before 9.15am will receive a late mark. Those arriving after 9.15am, will be classed as being absent for their morning session and lose their entire morning attendance mark. This is in line with statutory Department for Education attendance legislation.
